HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 173, L.D. 419, Bill, "An Act
to Amend the Workmen's Compensation Act."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last underlined
sentence and inserting in place thereof the following under-
lined sentences:

"In case the place of hearing so designated is more than
10 miles distant from the place where the accident occurred,
the employer shall provide transportation or reimburse the
employee for reasonable mileage in traveling within the State
to and from said hearing. The amount so allowed for such
travel shall be determined by the commissioner or commission
and awarded separately in the decree.' "
