#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting Bars in Hotels and Class A Restaurants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 30-A, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 30-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 30-A. Liquor served at certain bars or counters; authorized. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, hotels and class A restaurants may have bars or counters at which liquor may be served.'
