## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Business Hours of State Liquor Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 12, amended. Section 12 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 218 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Notwithstanding other provisions of this section except Sunday closing, state stores shall be kept open each day until 9 P. M. from July 1st until Labor Day. During other times of the year, they shall be kept open until 9 P. M. on Fridays and Saturdays and nights immediately preceding legal holidays.'
