AN ACT to Provide for Industrial Waste Elimination Research Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Purpose. It is necessary to eliminate pollution of our waters through industrial wastes, and there is no present source of research assistance available to the Department of Economic Development or other development agencies of the State to advise them on corrective measures for industrial waste problems of their prospects and expanding industries.

Sec. 2. Services. The Technology Experiment Station of the University of Maine is directed to provide such research services to the Department of Economic Development and its cooperating agencies.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 to the Technology Experiment Station of the University of Maine to carry out the purposes of this act. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse until June 30, 1963.
