STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing for Maine Potato Advertising by the Department of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 16, § 231, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 231 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 471 of the public laws of 1955 and by section 7 of chapter 123 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:
 - 'III. Advertising. A sum which shall equal at least 25% of the money collected shall be used by the Department of Agriculture for the general purpose of merchandising and advertising Maine potatoes for food and for seed purposes under the direction of the Maine Potato Commission. The commission may use the advice and facilities of the Department of Economic Development and the Department of Agriculture in carrying out the provisions of this subsection.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 16, § 232, amended. The next to the last sentence of section 232 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:
- 'The said commission may work with the Department of Economic Development and the Department of Agriculture in carrying out the provisions of sections 222 to 233.'
