COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 300, L. D. 452, Bill, "An Act Relating to Tuition Pupils as Basis for State Aid for School Construction."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the single quotation mark, the following underlined sentence: 'Any municipality qualifying for school construction aid under this section by virtue of receiving tuition students from surrounding municipalities must render at least 2 years' notice to the sending municipalities before discontinuing such acceptance.'
