AN ACT Providing for Municipal Court Conferences.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 108, § 13, additional. Chapter 108 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 13, to read as follows:

'Sec. 13. Municipal court conferences. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court may from time to time call together the several judges, associate judges and recorders of municipal courts, and the trial justices, or such of them as he may designate, at such place as he may appoint for conference as to conduct and dispatch of judicial business and interchange of views in matters of practice. Such persons shall be entitled to their actual cash disbursements in attending such conferences or such other meetings in connection therewith as the Chief Justice may call.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$1,250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963.
