**AN ACT Relating to Use of Motor Boats on Jerry Pond,
Penobscot County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 67-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 67-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 67-A. Restricting the use of motor boats. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to use motors on watercraft, in and upon the waters of Jerry Pond, so called, situated within the boundaries, or having a shore line abutting, the incorporated municipality of Millinocket and the unincorporated townships being T. I, R. 7 and T. A, R. 7, all in the County of Penobscot.'
