COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 330, L. D. 482, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Revenues for Lewiston Parking  
District."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Emergency  
Preamble.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the  
first 5 lines of the Emergency clause and referendum and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Referendum; effective date. This act shall take  
effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature, only  
for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal  
voters of the City of Lewiston at the next regular city  
election, or at a special election to be called and held  
for the purpose within 3 months after the effective date of'
