## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Depositing Refuse.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 137, § 30, repealed and replaced. Section 30 of chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 206 of the public laws of 1955, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 30. Throwing, depositing and dumping of refuse; penalty; enforcement. If any person shall put or place, or cause to be put or placed, in or upon any highway, street, square, lane, alley, public bathing place or the approaches thereto, or into or on the ice over any public waters, streams or watercourse or other public place in any municipality any bottles, glass, crockery, cans, scrap metal, junk, paper, garbage, old automobile or parts thereof or refuse of any nature whatsoever or any noxious thing, he shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100. Nothing in this section shall be construed as affecting authorized collections of such articles as garbage or refuse.

State and local enforcement officials are authorized to enforce this section.'
