RESOLVE, Designating Certain Waters in Porter as "Black Lake."

Certain waters in Porter designated. Resolved: That the waters held by the dam constructed during 1960 in Week's Meadow in the Town of Porter, Oxford County, by the Saddleback Rod and Gun Club, of Kezar Falls, be officially named and referred to as "Black Lake."
