STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for Pension for Jerome Goodchild of Augusta.

Jerome Goodchild; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be granted to Jerome Goodchild, of Augusta, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pension. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Goodchild worked for the State for 19 years and 2 months. Retired in January 1959 and was not a member of the State Retirement System. He is 73 years of age and is ill.
