IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Repealing Certain Laws Permitting Taking of Clams for Bait Purposes in Polluted Areas.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1959, c. 155, § 126, repealed. Section 26 of chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959, which relates to taking clams in Biddeford for bait, is repealed.
- Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1959, c. 155, § 128, repealed. Section 128 of chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959, which relates to taking clams on flats of Kennebunk River, is repealed.
- Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1959, c. 155, § 129, repealed. Section 129 of chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959, which relates to taking clams on flats of Mousam River, is repealed.
