STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT to Clarify State Disbursements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15-A, § 19, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 19 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

Every disbursement from the treasury shall be upon the authorization of the State Controller and the Treasurer of State, as evidenced by their facsimile signatures, which authorization shall be in the form of a warrant drawn in favor of the payee, and said warrant shall, upon being countersigned by the Treasurer of State and delivered by the Treasurer of State to the payee, become a check against a designated bank or trust company acting as a depository of the State Government.'
