AN ACT Permitting Counties to Expend Money for Advisory Organizations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 166 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 16. Advertising or promoting appropriation. Any county may expend not exceeding the sum of \$5,000 annually under the direction of the county commissioners, to be accounted for as other moneys of the county, for advertising or promoting the natural resources, advantages and attractions of such county and in obtaining the services of municipal and county advisory organizations.'
