STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Exempting Town of Alfred from Apportionment of County Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town of Alfred exempt from apportionment of county tax. The Town of Alfred, York County, shall be exempt from the county tax which may be apportioned by York County under the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 89, section 15.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The county owns free from municipal taxation land and buildings in the Town of Alfred, namely the county courthouse and land appurtenant thereto, the county jail and land appurtenant thereto, and many other parcels of vacant land which in the aggregate takes out of local taxation property which it may be reasonably supposed would yield to the town an amount in taxes far in excess of Alfred's apportionment of the county tax which runs to about \$1,200 to \$1,300 per year at the present time.
