STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 3rd paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of public laws of 1959, which relates to the salary of the county attorney and assistant county attorney of Aroostook County, is amended to read as follows:

'county attorney, \$3,500 \$5,000; assistant county attorney, \$2,500 \$3,500;'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to provide for the increase in salaries of the county attorney and assistant county attorney of Aroostook County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
