STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Attending School in Administrative Units in Another State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 93, amended. Section 93 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the first sentence, a new sentence, as follows:

'When an administrative unit adjacent to an administrative unit in another state has too few scholars for the profitable maintenance of an elementary school or when pupils live remote from any public elementary school in an administrative unit in which they reside, the superintending school committee or school directors may pay tuition and provide conveyance to a school in an administrative unit adjacent to the State of Maine in another state.'
