STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Black Bass Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 37, § 44, sub-§ VI, additional. Section 44 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection VI to read as follows:
 - 'VI. Black bass. In any waters where the bag limit on black bass has been removed by rule and regulation of the commissioner, the season on black bass and the method of fishing for them shall be the same as for trout and salmon.'
