COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 203, L.D. 536, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Disability Benefits Under Maine State Retirement
System."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of paragraph E and
inserting in place thereof the following:

"'E. Any increases in benefits granted to teachers by the
Legislature shall be applicable to disability retirants who
have 25 years of creditable service, on a pro rata basis,
which shall apply to those who have retired or will hereafter
retire under any other provision of this chapter. Recomputa-
tion of such disability benefits shall be made by the actuary
as of the effective date of this act.'"
