AN ACT Relating to Disability Benefits Under Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 6, sub-§ II, ¶ E, additional. Subsection II of section 6 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, and as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph E, to read as follows:

'E. Any increases in benefits granted to teachers by the Legislature shall be applicable to disability retirants on a pro rata basis, as well as those who have retired or will hereafter retire under any other provision of this chapter. Re-computation of such disability benefits shall be made by the actuary in the event of such a change in the law, effective as of the date this act is approved.'
