STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain Officers of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. I. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to Lincoln County, is amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln County: County commissioners, \$800 **\$900**; clerk of courts, \$3,500 \$3,850; county attorney, \$2,500 \$3,000; treasurer, \$1,000; sheriff, \$3,000 \$3,300; register of deeds, \$3,200 \$3,500; judge of probate, \$2,800 \$3,000; register of probate, \$2,600 \$2,850; Lincoln municipal court judge, \$2,800 \$3,000; recorder. \$1.800 \$2.000.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1961.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1061; the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to provide for the in-crease in salary of the county attorney of Lincoln County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
