**AN ACT Increasing Salary and Expenses of Judge of Western Somerset
Municipal Court.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 14th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to the salary of the judge of Western Somerset municipal court, is amended to read as follows :

'Western Somerset municipal court judge, ~~\$3,500~~ \$4,000;'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1909, c. 331, § 8, amended. The first sentence of section 8 of chapter 331 of the private and special laws of 1909, as last amended by chapter 194 of the private and special laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows :

'As compensation for his services in that capacity the judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of \$3,500, payable in quarterly installments from the treasury of the county of Somerset, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October, and in addition shall receive his necessary traveling expenses, including mileage allowance, hotel expenses, meals, etc., when holding court in another town than that in which he resides, and he The judge shall receive for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties, a sum not exceeding \$500, and shall receive an additional sum of \$1,500 per year for clerk hire and such additional amount as may be authorized by the county commissioners.'
