AN ACT Relating to Furnishing List of Recipients of Aid to the Blind for Motor Vehicle Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 318-A, additional. Chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 318-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 318-A. List furnished Secretary of State. The Department of Health and Welfare shall furnish to the Secretary of State a list of all recipients of aid to the blind and services for the blind. This list shall be used only for the purpose of determining if such recipient is a proper person to have a motor vehicle operator's license.'
