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**Arnold Tobin; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be appropriated from the Dog Tax Fund the sum of \$136 to be paid to Arnold Tobin, of Temple, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for hens killed by skunks.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Skunks killed 272 chicks at the farm of Arnold Tobin. They were only 5 weeks old. They were killed on a Sunday and the claim could not be made at the town office until Monday. The evidence had to be removed on Sunday.
