RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Rumford for Aid to Isabelle Morgan and Family.

Town of Rumford; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$156.62 to be paid to the Town of Rumford for aid given Isabelle Morgan and family.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Morgan was committed to the State Hospital in Augusta on April 3, 1956. On a "Care Pending Hearing Order," her children were committed to the homes of Mrs. Reba Hatfield and Mr. and Mrs. Walter Goding. The total cost to the Town of Rumford was for \$292.62. It is understandable that the amount of \$136 was chargeable to the town as this amount represents actual expenditures on the "Care Pending Hearing Order" dated April 4, 1956. However, the other needs were for Mrs. Morgan and the children which might have been delayed until the children were committed to the State on April 18, 1956. The amount of \$156.62 should be reimbursed by the State to the Town of Rumford.
