RESOLVE, Reimbursing Walter Bailey, Lincoln, for Injuries to Horse.

Walter Bailey; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund of the State the sum of \$165 to be paid to Walter Bailey, of Lincoln, in settlement of his claim against the State for injuries to his horse.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The State Highway Commission installed a culvert on Mr. Bailey's property at Lincoln to drain the surface water from U. S. highway #2. It was the understanding that the Highway Commission was to maintain said culvert.

On July 14, 1960, while Mr. Bailey was driving his horse from one field to another on his property, the horse fell into said culvert, which had rusted, and was injured and was of no use to Mr. Bailey after being injured. Mr. Bailey's claim to the State is for \$165.
