STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Screening Outlets of Waters Reclaimed and Restocked.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 21-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 21-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 21-A. Outlets of reclaimed waters screened. All reclaimed ponds and lakes after restocking shall have all outlets screened and shall be closed to fishing for one year after such restocking.'
