HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 400, L.D. 575, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Ways to Great Ponds."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in place thereof the following title: "An Act Relating
to Paths to Great Ponds in Unorganized Territory."

Further amend said Bill by striking out that part designated
"Sec. 43-A." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 43-A. Paths to great ponds in unorganized territory.
The county commissioners of any county may lay out, alter or
discontinue paths or trails in the unorganized territory of the
county which will provide a right of access to great ponds,
provided a request therefor is made by petition signed by not less
than 40 residents of said county. Such trails or paths shall not
exceed 10 feet in width.'
