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

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Ways to Great Ponds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 43-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 43-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 43-A. Ways to great ponds. County commissioners may lay out, alter or discontinue ways which will provide a right of access to great ponds.'
