STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Exempting Oil Burnermen from Plumbing License Requirements for Specific Installations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 192, amended. Section 192 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 192. Exceptions. The provisions of sections Sections 178 to 193 shall not apply to regular employees of public utilities as defined in section 16 of chapter 44, section 16, when working as such, nor to regular employees of owners or lessees of real property when working as such, nor to persons licensed to make oil burner installations as defined in chapter 82-A, nor to persons whose occupation is the doing of miscellaneous jobs of manual labor in the course of which some incidental plumbing repairs or alterations are made by them.'
