COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 411, L.D. 586, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Nursing Home in Town of Mars Hill."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the  
following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do  
not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless  
enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the hospitalization and nursing care of people in  
and around the Town of Mars Hill is an obligation and duty of  
the Town of Mars Hill; and

Whereas, in order to provide such hospitalization and  
nursing care a nursing home in the Town of Mars Hill should be  
constructed as soon as possible this year; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following  
emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the  
preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
