AN ACT Relating to Nursing Home in Town of Mars Hill.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

'Mars Hill to raise money for nursing home. The Town of Mars Hill, Aroostook County, may raise or appropriate money to provide for or support a nursing home in the Town of Mars Hill for the hospitalization or nursing care of human beings, provided that said nursing home shall be organized under the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 54. The Town of Mars Hill shall have a lien on such nursing home equal to the amount of money appropriated and turned over in the aggregate by the Town of Mars Hill to the said nursing home, which lien may be enforced in the same manner and with the same effect as the lien on real estate set forth in the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 91-A, section 89, as enacted by the public laws of 1955, chapter 399, section 1, whenever the said nursing home ceases to be a nursing home organized under said Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 54. Such lien shall be subject to the prior payment of all claims of the United States of America, mortgage liens, notes and debentures and operating indebtedness incident to the construction, equipping and operating said nursing home.'
