HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 416, L.D. 591, Bill, "An Act to

Include the Town of Winslow in the Kennebec Water District."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1899, c. 200, §1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 200 of the private and special laws of 1899, as last repealed and replaced by chapter 38 of the private and special laws of 1945, is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Incorporation. The territory and people formerly constituting the Kennebec Water District and the Town of Winslow shall eentine constitute a body politic and corporate for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of said district and of the Towns of Fairfield, Benton,-Winslew and Vassalboro and all said municipalities with pure water for domestic and for all other lawful purposes, including municipal, manufacturing, commercial and industrial purposes. The records of the Kennebec Water District are public and meetings of the trustees shall be open.' "
