RESOLVE, to Increase Retirement Benefit of Walter A. Locke, of Augusta.

Retirement benefit of Walter A. Locke; increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Walter A. Locke, of Augusta, under chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, be increased to the amount of \$70 per month, effective as of January 1, 1961.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Locke retired from state employment after having completed approximately 32 years of service on a monthly retirement benefit of \$47.80.

He was born February 2, 1887 and obviously, due to his advanced age and physical condition, is in need of additional income.
