STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Judge and Recorder of Caribou Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 3rd paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to the salaries of the Caribou municipal court judge and recorder is amended to read as follows:

'Caribou municipal court judge ~~\$3,600~~ \$4,000; recorder, ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,000.'
