STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 11th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to Penobscot County, is amended to read as follows:

'Penobscot County: County commissioners, \$2,250; clerk of courts, \$4,350 for the year 1959 and \$4,450 annually thereafter \$5,000; deputy clerk of courts, \$3,600 \$4,000; county attorney, \$4,200; assistant county attorney, \$3,300; treasurer, \$3,250; sheriff, \$5,500; register of deeds, \$4,500; judge of probate, \$5,000; register of probate, \$4,000; Bangor municipal court judge, \$4,000; recorder associate judge, \$3,500; Brewer municipal court judge, \$2,000; recorder associate judge, \$1,200; Dexter municipal court judge, \$7,000; Town of Lincoln municipal court judge, \$2,500; recorder, \$1,600; Millinocket municipal court judge, \$2,500; recorder, \$1,600; Newport municipal court judge, \$1,700; Old Town municipal court judge, \$2,500; recorder, \$1,600.'
