STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials and Judges and Recorders of Municipal Courts in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 16th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959 and as amended by section 61 of chapter 378 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to Washington County, is further amended to read as follows:

'Washington County: County commissioners, \$1,800; clerk of courts, \$2,500 \$2,800; county attorney, \$3,300; treasurer, \$2,400 \$2,600; sheriff, \$4,000 \$4,500; register of deeds, \$2,900 \$3,200; judge of probate, \$2,500 \$3,000; register of probate, \$2,800 \$3,100; Calais municipal court judge, \$3,000 \$3,500; recorder, \$600 \$1,200; Eastport municipal court judge, \$1,200; recorder, \$400; Western Washington municipal court judge, \$3,000 \$3,500; recorder, \$1,200.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1961.
