STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Length of Motor Vehicle Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ III, amended. The 4th paragraph from the end of subsection III of section 16 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 309 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'No motor vehicle, or combination of motor vehicle and trailer or semi-trailer, except fire department vehicles, shall exceed in length 50 60 feet over-all including all structural parts thereof, permanent or temporary, and any load carried thereon or therein.'
