AN ACT Authorizing Green Blinker Lights on Doctors' Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 144-B, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 144-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 144-B. Signal lights for doctors' authorized. A green blinker or flashing green signal light, not more than 5 inches in diameter, may be mounted as near as practicable above the registration plate on the front of a motor vehicle operated by any doctor or physician licensed to practice in this State. Such light may be displayed but shall not be in operation except while such vehicle is in use during emergencies. No doctor or physician shall operate a green blinker or flashing green signal light upon such motor vehicle except while actually enroute to the scene of an emergency requiring his professional services.'
