## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Duplicate Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 63, amended. Section 63 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 63. Duplicate license. In the event that an operator's license or registration card issued under the provisions of this chapter shall be lost or destroyed, the person to whom the same was issued may obtain a duplicate or substitute thereof upon furnishing proof satisfactory to the Secretary of State that such license or card has been lost or destroyed and upon payment of a fee of 25e 50c.

If the Secretary of State is satisfied that public safety will not be endangered, he may issue, upon payment of a fee of 50c, a duplicate license to a person who has an original license.'
