STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Temporary Driver's Permit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. The 15th sentence of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 181 of the public laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:

'The Secretary of State may, in his discretion, issue a temporary driver's permit to an applicant who has successfully passed a complete examination, or to an applicant who holds a valid or recently expired operator's license from another state or country, permitting applicant to operate a motor vehicle during a period not to exceed 30 days while the Secretary of State is completing his investigation and determination of all facts relative to such applicant's right to receive an operator's license. The Secretary of State may, in his discretion, issue a temporary driver's permit to any resident permitting the operation of a motor vehicle during a period not to exceed 30 days.'
