AN ACT Clarifying the Renewal of Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. The 2nd and 3rd paragraphs of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 121 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended by section 2 of chapter 10 of the public laws of 1959, are further amended to read as follows:

~~'All renewal licenses to operate motor vehicles issued after December 31, 1958 shall expire annually at midnight on the anniversary of license holder's date of birth. The fee for such license shall be computed at the rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ of such annual license fee per quarter or any fractional part thereof.~~

All new **and renewal** licenses to operate motor vehicles ~~issued after December 31, 1958~~ shall expire at midnight on the license holder's birthday next following the date of issuance of said license. The fee for such license shall be \$2.'
