**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Parmachenee Lake, Parmachenee and
Lynchtown, Oxford County.**

Resolves, 1955, c. 104, amended. Resolved: That the 27th paragraph of that part designated "Oxford County" of chapter 104 of the resolves of 1955, be amended to read as follows:

'Parmachenee Lake, Parmachenee and Lynchtown. ~~Fly fishing and trolling with artificial flies only.~~ Use or possession of live fish as bait prohibited. Daily limit 5 fish.'
