STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Minimum Wages for Summer Camp Employees and Students.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 30, § 132-B, sub-§ III, ¶ E, repealed. Paragraph E of subsection III of section 132-B of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 362 of the public laws of 1959, is repealed as follows:

'E. Those employees of summer camps for boys or girls under the age of 19 who are counselors, or junior counselors; or employees of any business who are regularly enrolled in an educational institution, or are on vacation therefrom;'
