IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE to Reimburse Old Town School Department for Tuition for Children Living on Indian Island.

Old Town school department; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$10,400.37 to be paid to the school department of the City of Old Town to pay said city for the tuition of non-Indian children living on Indian Island for the school years beginning September 1958 through June 1963. The money shall be paid only upon the presentation of proper bills by the City of Old Town to the Department of Education.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are many non-Indian children living on Indian Island and attending Old Town public schools. The Legislature, in 1959, passed a resolve covering tuition for the school years 1956-57, 1957-58 and 1958-59. The amount for 1958-59 was given in error and there is \$194.30 still due the City of Old Town. The full sum of \$10,400.37 is arrived at as follows:
