HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 464, L.D. 664, Resolve, in Favor
of Jim Adams, Inc. of Bangor.

Amend said Resolve by striking out everything after the
title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Jim Adams, Inc.; reimbursed.

Resolved: That there is appropriated as a moral obligation
of the State of Maine from the Unappropriated Surplus of the
General Fund the sum of \$9,500 to compensate in part said
Jim Adams, Inc., of Bangor for damage suffered by unnecessary,
careless and harmful acts of state supervised contractors and
employees, state agents and employees, both during and after
the construction of the Bangor-Brewer bridge.'
