IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Providing for Voting Place in Rockwood.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 5, § 64-A, additional. Chapter 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 64-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 64-A. Rockwood voting place. The municipal officers of Greenville are directed to establish a voting place at Rockwood, an unorganized township in the County of Somerset, for all state and national elections, including primary elections, at which voting place all residents of Rockwood may cast their ballots. The municipal officers shall prepare a separate list of such voters and all persons whose names are so included in said list shall be entitled to vote at said voting place in Rockwood.

Municipal officers of Greenville shall select 4 ballot clerks from the inhabitants of Rockwood, representing the 2 political parties which at the gubernatorial election next preceding such appointment cast the greatest number of votes and shall select a warden.

The conduct of elections at said voting place shall be the same as in towns having separate voting districts, and all laws with respect to separate voting districts in towns are made applicable to said voting place at Rockwood and the powers and duties of municipal officers in such case are conferred upon the municipal officers of the Town of Greenville.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 16, § 105-A, additional. Chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 105-A, to read as follows:

'Excise Taxes in Rockwood.

Sec. 105-A Excise taxes in Rockwood. The excise taxes on motor vehicles assessed and collected by the State from the inhabitants of Rockwood shall be paid by the State to the Town of Greenville.'
