IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Repealing Oosoola Stream Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 149, repealed. That part of section 149 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, which relates to Oosoola Stream Game Preserve is repealed as follows:

'Ossoola Stream Game Preserve. Ossoola Stream, commonly called Mill Stream, situated in the Town of Norridgewock, is closed to all hunting or trapping up to the high water mark, from Jewett's line, so called, down to Percival's saw mill, which mill is located near the mouth of said Ossala Stream.'
