IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Powers of Arrest by Inland Fish and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 24, amended. Section 24 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'The wardens shall have the authority to arrest any person who assaults, intimidates or in any manner willfully obstructs or hinders any inland fish and game warden while in the lawful discharge of his duties.
